Good afternoon CVPC,

I am writing today to provide you with a quick update regarding the status of the USPS FOIA request in which the Department is working to obtain additional information regarding postal locations in California. I've also attached, in Word and PDF, the June 15 follow-up letter that was sent to the USPS asking for the additional information.

Following is a chronology of steps we have taken with the USPS to obtain the additional information:

- * June 15, 2018- Sent FOIA requests for additional information including addresses and phone number and clarification regarding distributions centers.
- * July 20, 2018- Sent follow-up email regarding the 6/15/2018 FIOA request
- * July 20, 2018- Received response from Marthea Hodge, USPS. She provided an update of the San Diego PO previously provided by Ms. Bush. She indicated that the additional information would need to be requested from Ms. Service.
- * July 20, 2018- Forwarded 6/15/2018 FOIA request to Ms. Service per Ms. Hodge's email.
- * August 21, 2018- Follow-up with Ms. Service regarding the July 20 FOIA request.
- * September 10, 2018- Follow-up with Ms. Service regarding the August 21 FOIA request.

We will continue to keep you apprised of any updates regarding the FOIA.
